We are pleased to announce that the **22nd Annual Workshop of the National Reference Laboratories for Fish Diseases** will be held in May 30th - 31st at the premises of the Technical University of Denmark in Kgs. Lyngby, Denmark. Please see the enclosed map and instructions for guidance.

<u>Please note that no official invitation will be sent from the Commission to the CVO of your country</u> and it will be our responsibility as NRL to assure the participation of the right colleagues.

The cost for holding the workshop is funded by the European Commission through the EURL and the Commission Regulation allows us to cover travel and hotel expenses as well as meals for one participant from each EU Member State. In addition, one person from non-Member, but associated countries, is allowed reimbursement. For practical reasons (limited space); if more than one participant from each country wishes to participate, it should be arranged with the organisers. Due to budget restrictions, we kindly ask you to reserve your flight ticket as soon as possible and take advantage of "early bird" reservations in order to keep expenses as low as possible.

Please consider that:

- If you take part in the Workshop as <u>invited speaker</u>, <u>NRL representative of an EU Member</u> <u>State</u> (one for each Member State) or <u>NRL representative of an associate Member State</u> (one for each associated country) select the corresponding type of registration when signing up. In these cases:
 - You will have to arrange your hotel reservation with the form attached to this letter and specify that DTU will cover the related expenses in the form.
 - You will have to reserve and pay your flight ticket (it will be reimbursed afterwards).
 - You <u>WILL NOT</u> have to transfer money related to the banquet dinner, lunches or coffees.
 - You will have to scan and send us flight boarding cards, invoices/receipts with factual paid amount for travel expenses and other costs incurred in connection with your travel (meals, metro, parking, etc. but no taxi fares will be refunded) and hotel receipts. You will then be reimbursed as quickly as possible.

 0.5 km, about 8 min
- Inter-city Rail: Take E Hillerød St.

- Walk: From Lyngby St. to Lyngby St. 65 m, about 1 min 5 minutes to make the connection
